

CHRISTeans 2010

Where should I start? CHRISTeans 2010 was a great weekend. We were able to bless people on another continent as well as people in our neighborhood. Seventeen people became followers of Jesus! We heard inspiring messages from guys like Patrick Mead from Rochester Hills, Michigan, Anthony Wood from Newport, Arkansas, and Sean Algaier from the last season of the “Biggest Loser”.

Lifebread (a non-profit organization dedicated to empowering the people of impoverished nations through nutritional education and food preparation training as a means to curb the severity of world hunger) was with us again this year. Basically, they build ovens in Africa and teach people to use them so they continue feeding a village long after they've visited. We were able to raise nearly \$5,000 during CHRISTeans weekend for this mission. We were also able to collect food items for Russellville Junior High. Through conversations with Mrs. Alene Bynum, principal at RJHS, we discovered that there are many students at the junior high who are in need of food, not only for lunch, but also to take home to their families. So, we provided a huge pile to donate to them. In fact, Keith Moore and I filled one student's backpack with food on Thursday. It would be a shame to gather 1,000 people together in the name of Jesus and not do something to bless someone. After all, that's what will cause the world to stop and take notice. “And if you spend yourselves in behalf of the hungry and satisfy the needs of the oppressed, then your light will shine in the darkness, and your night will become like the noonday” (Is. 58:10).

Seventeen people committed their lives to Christ on Saturday night during CHRISTeans. Among those seventeen who were baptized, eight of them are connected to West Side: Sarah Cole, Mallory Harrison, Joseph Roberds, Kailey Parchman, Hailey Bates, Madi Houser, Chandler Russell, and Garrison Rhodes. And Wednesday night, after class, Erin Reid was baptized. We prayed for months leading up to the event for people's hearts to be changed by what took place at CHRISTeans. Obviously, our prayers were answered.

All in all, it was a great weekend. It was encouraging, inspiring, thought provoking, and challenging. Thank you to everyone who made it a reality! CHRISTeans has become one of the highlights of my year. We just celebrated our 25th anniversary. I hope our church will still be doing it in twenty-five years.

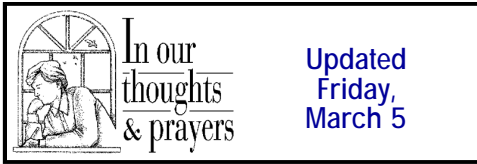
